Homework:

- Have available the 4 reference photos of skies: Sky Reference 1-4. (Either print them or download to a device you can display them on at the same time as you view the lesson)
- Prepare two sheets of watercolor paper as follows: (Note, I will be using a 12x16" sheet of Arches rough paper for the first demonstration and then the same size of Arches hot press for the second)
 - Use a strip of masking tape to divide each sheet in half vertically and then another strip to divide it in half horizontally, yielding 4 equal rectangles on the page, each measuring about 5x7". (The sample painting provided after the reference photos may help illustrate these directions)


