## Homework:

- Print or download 1 reference photo: Green Fields
- Have several sheets of watercolor paper on hand to practice color mixing exercises. If you have a variety of tubes of blue paint and yellow paint (in addition to the ones on the materials list provided), feel welcome to have them nearby to experiment. If you only have the recommended paints, those will be sufficient for the exercise.
- After the color mixing exercises, we will paint the rural scene. If time permits, we will first paint a black and white study, so have two drawings prepared just in case.
- Print or download the $8 \times 10$ " drawing provided. Use this drawing as a guide to draw the scene on two separate sheets of watercolor paper. You will use one sheet for the black and white exercise and the second for the painting in color.
- My paper will be $8 \times 10$ " for each of the paintings. Please note I use the same quality paper for both my black and white sketches and for my color paintings.
